

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy demonstrates WoRinWell by WoRisGo (“Our” “Us” “We”) commitment to maintaining the privacy of all data collected, describes the information we collect; how we use, disclose, and share that information; and how we protect the information.

A. PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

We do not collect data other than the email of the user and the patient details as sent in by the requestor. This information is bound by the mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).

B. WHY DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION

We collect information to improve and develop WoRinWell by WoRisGo’s services and products. We have legitimate interests in the effective delivery of information and services to you.

The use of your data includes and is not limited to:

1. facilitating your assistance, should you need it;
2. conducting market research for meeting our requirements;
3. administering your use of our services;
4. business planning and product development;
5. reviewing and improving our services;
6. responding to your questions or suggestions;
7. receiving professional advice, such as legal or financial advice, links to medical services (to provide information on medical matters to the doctors/hospitals);
8. sending periodical emails regarding your requests or information about our products and services; and
9. doing anything we are required to do by law or on the direction of a relevant authority, including to assist in connection with legal proceedings, crime or fraud protection, detection and prosecution;

We also collect, use and share data such as statistical or demographic data for any purpose. Such aggregated data may be derived from your personal data but is not considered personal data in law as this data does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity. Such data will be used for statistical analysis and reporting, to help improve our services or for research purposes.

You can control your personal data that we have obtained, and exercise your data protection rights, by contacting us.

C. HOW DO WE COLLECT YOUR INFORMATION

We collect information from you through direct interactions and through automated interactions. Through direct interactions when you may give us your identity, contact and financial data by filling in forms or by corresponding with us by post, phone, email or otherwise. This includes personal data you provide if you:

- a. apply for our products or services;
- b. create an account on our website through registration;
- c. subscribe to our service or publications;
- d. request marketing to be sent to you;
- e. give us your business card;
- f. give us some feedback.

As you interact with our website, we may automatically collect technical data about your equipment IP address and patterns. We collect this personal data by using cookies, server logs and other similar technologies. We may also receive technical data about you if you visit other websites employing our cookies. Please see our Cookie Policy.

D. LOCATION BASED TOOLS

We may collect and use the geographical location of your computer or mobile device, however, this will not happen without your express consent. This helps the us in customising service delivery. Location data is collected for the purpose of providing you with information, assessment, analysis or insights regarding services which we believe may be of interest to you based on your geographic location, and we believe will enhance customer experience. You may switch off the locator services in your mobile device anytime.

E. NO TRANSMISSION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We will not transmit the information to a third party without the consent from the corporate. We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer any data to outside parties.

F. THIRD-PARTY LINKS

We do not include or offer third-party products or services on our website.

G. COMMITMENT TO SECURITY

We have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security safeguards that will help prevent unauthorized access, maintain data security, ensure privacy and correctly use the information that we collect. We recognise that no system can be completely

secure, however, we are unable to guarantee total security. Given the dynamic nature of the environment the we operate in, security cannot be guaranteed against all threats.

H. RETENTION & DISCLOSURE

We securely store your information, and hold it for as long as we need to in order provide our services and products to you in accordance with (i) applicable law, or (ii) as long as is set out in any relevant contract your firm has with us. The law of the land where we operate may require the Company to retain the record for a longer period.

We review the retention period as the need arises.

We may have legal duty to disclose or report suspicious transactions and other illegal activity that it may become aware to the relevant regulatory authorities under various legislation including but not limited to terrorist financing, insider dealing, anti-money laundering, or related legislations. In some cases, it may be prevented by law to inform you about this in advance of the disclosure, or at all.

I. TRANS--BORDER DATA FLOWS

We may transmit personal information outside India if we consider it is appropriate to do so to most efficiently supply our services to you. By providing your personal information to us you consent to such transfer.

J. YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

Depending on the country of your residence, you may have rights under your local law in relation to the information we hold about you. You could therefore approach us to:

1. Seek confirmation from us as to whether we possess any personal data about you.
2. Request correction of the personal data that we hold about you.
3. Withdraw your consent at any time. Since we deal with corporate contracts, this request must be channeled through your account manager at your company.
